INTRODUCTION





DAY 1	 Zurich - Lucerne Arrive in the afternoon in Zurich and get on to Lucerne by private transport, also known as the heart of Switzerland. After check-in, explore the old town. The Chapel Bridge is the most iconic attraction in Lucerne and the oldest wooden bridge in Switzerland, dating back to the 14th century. The Chapel Bridge stretches 200 meters across the Reuss River. 	Overnight in Lucerne
DAY 2	 Lucerne - Grindelwald After breakfast, we will be leaving Lucerne by private transport and go to Grindelwald. This Glacier Village lies in a valley situated in the Bernese Oberland on the northern side of the Alps and is surrounded by spectacular mountain trio "Eiger, Mönch and Jungfrau". Grindelwald is still small and has kept its country charm. Visit the nearby village Lauterbrunnen, we will head to the Staubbach Falls, the most famous attraction here and watch the waterfalls flowing down. 	Overnight in Grindelwald Breakfast provided
DAY 3	 Grindelwald Day Trip After breakfast, we will be heading to the most anticipated attraction of the journey, a place where almost everyone who travels to Switzerland will not miss — Jungfrau. We will reach the peak of Jungfrau by railway and cable car. Jungfrau, the top of Europe, influenced by the rising Alps, and becomes a place in the clouds with many majestic peaks. The village is located under the Alps at the altitude of about 2000 meters. The town has 65 hot springs that provide a total of 3.9 million liters of hot spring water everyday. Leukerbad is the most famous spa resort in Switzerland and one of the not to be missed activity during winter season. Truly a special experience to indulge in the hot spring bath while admiring the spectacular view of the Alps. 	Overnight in Leukerbad Breakfast provided
DAY 5	 Leukerbad - Zermatt After breakfast, we will continue our journey from Leukerbad to Zermatt, one of the most beautiful towns in Switzerland. Passing by beautiful farmland, vast mountains and deep valleys. Chill and walk around in Zermatt, the town of Matterhorn. The Matterhorn (4,478 m) is famous all over the world for its unique pyramid shape. The famous Toblerone chocolate was also inspired by Matterhorn. 	Overnight in Zermatt Breakfast provided
DAY 6	 Zermatt Day Trip - sledding / ski experience After breakfast, we will take the cog railway (Gornergrat Bahn) to the end station - Gornergrat (3,135 m) and admire the spectacular view of the Gornergrat glacier also known as - the city of glacier. During winter season, Zermatt is one of the famous ski resort ; in spring and summer has the classic walk of the Riffelsee alpine lake and admire the reflection of the Matterhorn. Whether it's the perfect skiing season in winter or hiking in the summer, Zermatt surely has the amazing experience. 	Overnight in Zermatt Breakfast provided


