## INTRODUCTION

Norway is undoubtedly one of the world's most beautiful countries, known for its stunning fjords, the spectacular Northern Lights, and several fantastically modern, yet somehow charming cities. The name of the country was originally the "Road to the North". Legend tells that the ancient Nordic people traveled between Scandinavia and there was a "North Road" along the northern coast of the island, hence the name.

Norway is located in the western part of Scandinavia in Northern Europe. Its north extends to the northernmost point of Europe whereas the south faces Denmark across the sea. Norway has many coastal islands, reaching 150,000 and it is one of the countries with the most mountains in Europe. Fjords, mountains, and glaciers account for about 75% of the country's land area.

### THINGS TO KNOW BEFORE GOING TO NORWAY:

- 1. Norway's weather is unpredictable. We may have to meet road closure when the weather is bad, and face unexpected situations at any time, and then change the itinerary / accommodation.
- 2. Some attractions require a short walk to reach.
- 3. Tour members need to have strong physical fitness, no underlying diseases (asthma, high blood pressure, heart disease) and enough equipment to withstand the cold temperature.
- 4. The aurora will be tracked throughout the journey, but the aurora is a peculiar natural phenomenon that requires luck and a positive mindset, and can only be seen when the weather is clear. If necessary, we may drive out to see it more closely, or may even have to stay up late in the car for hours, or outside in the freezing wind waiting for the aurora to appear. This activity is optional, and tour members can also choose to stay in the accommodation to rest.
- 5. This is a self-driving tour (our tour leader will be the driver, tour members don't need to drive). Accommodation will be changed almost everyday, so tour members can have a more complete Nordic stay experience, and most of them have formal kitchens and kitchen utensils for us to cook breakfast and dinner. We will choose hotels, Icelandic log cabins, local private houses or AirBnb, and Guesthouse or Apartments as accommodation options.
- 6. This group is suitable for those who love to make friends and nature. The tour members need to cooperate and help each other.
- 7. The rear compartment will be used to store everyone's luggage and ingredients bought in the supermarket. Due to the limited space in the carriage, the luggage of the tour members are: a medium suitcase (27inch) + a hand luggage bag + a small backpack.
