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INTRODUCTION

Greenland (Kalaallit Nunaat, which means "Land of People" in the Inuit language), an autonomous country ruled under the Kingdom of Denmark, is geographically a part of the North America continent but more politically associated with Europe.

Some of the most dramatic and spectacular polar landscapes can be found on this world's largest island. It is home to icebergs as tall as buildings, glaciers glowing in different shades of blue and a massive ice sheet that covers almost 80% of the mega-island.

Of course there is a lot more to Greenland than glaciers and ice. This nation offers layers of culture and history too. Almost 90% of the locals are Inuit who have a distinctive language and tradition.

A visit to Greenland is definitely an adventure of lifetime!

Fun facts about Greenland

Since this country is massively covered in glaciers, ice and snows, how did it get its name?

Greenland got its name from an Icelandic murderer who was exiled to the island - Erik the Red. He hoped that this name will attract more settlers. However, according to scientists, Greenland was indeed actually greener more than 2.5 million years ago.

THINGS TO KNOW BEFORE COMING TO GREENLAND

1. The weather in the Arctic Circle is unpredictable. We may have to meet with bad weather, hence face unexpected situations at any time such as flight cancellation. In this case, we will have to adapt the itinerary/ accommodation on the spot.
2. Tour members should embrace the unpredictable with optimism and bring on positive vibes, this ensure we always enjoy the beautiful scenery and memorable moments together.
3. Simple hiking is a must to reach some attractions.
4. Tour members need to have strong physical fitness, no underlying diseases (asthma, high blood pressure, heart disease) and enough equipment to withstand the cold temperature and strong wind.

DETAILS

- Departure: (According to the announcement on the FB page and website.)
- Number of tour members in a group: Minimum 8 pax to form a group, maximum 11 pax
- Tour leader: Organizer will make arrangements and adjustments according to the schedule of all tour leaders under Bucket List Ticked and the entry and exit policies of various countries

- Tour dates & Tour fee: Refer to FB page and website

Remark:

- Tour leader will inform tour members the details of flight, tour members will need to buy their own air tickets, as well as follow up the status of the ticket.
- Deposit is needed for seat reservation. First-come, first-available.

Term & Condition

1. A deposit is required for reservation. The full balance must be paid within the specified time frame, no later than 45 days before departure. Failure to comply may lead to reservation cancellation and deposit forfeiture.
- 2a). Cancellation of reservation must be made in writing to avoid any misunderstanding.
- 2b). If no replacement is found, cancellation charges apply based on when we receive notice:
 - 45 days or more before the date of departure - Forfeiture of tour deposit
 - 22 - 44 days before the date of departure - 70% of tour fare non-refundable
 - Within 21 days before the date of departure - 100% of tour fare non-refundable(No refund for fees already incurred and non-refundable from other relevant authorities, e.g., flight or train tickets)
3. If there are any unforeseen circumstances or uncontrollable/force majeure (weather, tide, nature factor, traffic delays/cancellations, illness, pandemic, strikes, war or other causes), the company reserve the right to make changes to/cancel itinerary or postpone the tour at any time, no refunds are available.
- 4a). A tour member must have: An international passport or other recognized travel documents which should be valid for at least 6 months from the date of return to the country of origin; The necessary visa and vaccination and health certificates as required by the various authorities of the countries to be visited.
- 4b). The company is not responsible for expenses, reimbursement, or tour price refund if a member is denied entry or deported due to improper documents or other reasons.
5. No refund or reduction will be made to any member in respect of airfare, accommodation, meals, sightseeing tours, transport or any other services which are included in the tour fare out not utilized by the tour member due to personal reasons.
6. The company reserves the right to cancel or withdraw any itinerary, or any reservation made for a client or decline to accept or retain any person from being a tour member if he is likely to endanger the health or safety, or impair the comfort or enjoyment of others on the tour.

DAY 1 FLIGHT DAY	Copenhagen Kastrup - Kangerlussuaq <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Noon flight [4h50m] from Copenhagen to Kangerlussuaq (English:"Big Fjord")- After check-in at hotel, walk around this small village- For dinner, we have the option to cook together as a group.	Accommodation: BnB in Kangerlussuaq (shared bathroom)
DAY 2 HIKING	Kangerlussuaq - Point 660 Ice Sheet <ul style="list-style-type: none">- After breakfast, we will drive to Point 660, located at the edge of Greenland's second-largest ice cap.- Upon arrival, we will learn how to use crampons and walking poles to walk on the ice.- We will hike on the ice cap for a total of about 3 hours (Glacier Hiking).- After returning to the starting point, we will drive back to the town.- For dinner, we have the option to cook together as a group.	Accommodation: BnB in Kangerlussuaq (shared bathroom) Breakfast included
DAY 3 FLIGHT DAY	Kangerlussuaq - Ilulissat (Flight may be affected by weather) <ul style="list-style-type: none">- After breakfast, we will head to the airport to catch the flight to Ilulissat ("Icebergs" in English).- Once we arrive, we will check-in then take a walk around, exploring this World Heritage-listed town.	Accommodation: BnB Hotel in Ilulissat Breakfast included
DAY 4	Ilulissat Day Trip <ul style="list-style-type: none">- After breakfast, we will kayak among icebergs and glaciers near the church in Ilulissat.- In the evening, we will take a boat trip to Ilulissat Icefjord to admire the massive icebergs and grand ice fjord.- If we're lucky, we might also spot some humpback whales along the way.	Accommodation: BnB Hotel in Ilulissat Breakfast included

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DAY 5 HIKING	Ilulissat <ul style="list-style-type: none">- After breakfast, we will go on a hiking tour of the UNESCO World Heritage Sermermiut Trail. (Hiking difficulty: one star)- We will have a picnic at the viewpoint, with massive icebergs right in front of us.- The total hiking distance is approximately 6 kilometers, taking around 2 hours to complete.	Accommodation: BnB Hotel in Ilulissat Breakfast included
DAY 6	Ilulissat (Sailing may be affected by weather) <ul style="list-style-type: none">- After breakfast, we will head to Eqi Sermia Glacier, one of the largest calving glaciers in Greenland.- On the way, we will pass by the fishing village of Oqaatstut, with only 30 inhabitants.- We will be able to hear and witness the massive calving of the glacier from a distance, with large chunks of ice breaking off and crashing into the water.	Accommodation: BnB Hotel in Ilulissat Breakfast included
DAY 7	Ilulissat <ul style="list-style-type: none">- After breakfast, 45 minute flightseeing over the coastal to spot iceberg from atop [optional activity]- Free and easy around the town	Accommodation: BnB Hotel in Ilulissat Breakfast included
DAY 8 FLIGHT DAY	Ilulissat - Kangerlussuaq - Copenhagen (Flight may be affected by weather) <ul style="list-style-type: none">- After breakfast, we will fly from Ilulissat to Kangerlussuaq.- In Kangerlussuaq, we will have a layover and then catch the next flight to Copenhagen Kastrup.- We will arrive in Copenhagen late at night local time.- This marks the end of this marvelous journey.	Accommodation: - Breakfast included
