The country's love for variety is evident, with three capitals, eleven official languages, 21 National Parks, and ten UNESCO World Heritage Sites. South Africa boasts a stunning natural landscape, including breathtaking wildlife reserves, beaches, and mountains. Some of the most popular attractions include Kruger National Park, Table Mountain, the Cape of Good Hope, and the Drakensberg Mountains.

THINGS TO KNOW BEFORE COMING TO SOUTH AFRICA:

1. South Africa has a varied climate depending on the region, so make sure to pack appropriate clothing. In Cape Town you can enjoy warm day and cooler night during April, while areas such as Kruger National Park can be hot and humid year-round.

a. Johannesburg: 9°C/21°C

b. Kruger National Park: 18°C/30°C

c.Cape Town: 12°C/25°C d.Hermanus: 11°C/23°C

- 2. Some regions of South Africa such as Kruger National Park are at risk for malaria, so make sure to consult with your doctor before traveling and take appropriate precautions such as taking antimalarial medication or using insect repellent.
- 3. Yellow fever is not endemic in South Africa, meaning that the virus is not regularly found in the local population or animals. However, travelers coming from countries where yellow fever is present may be required to show proof of yellow fever vaccination upon arrival in South Africa to prevent the spread of the virus.
- 4. South Africa has a high crime rate, it is recommended to take extra precautions for personal safety. Be aware of your surroundings and avoid carrying large amounts of cash or wearing expensive jewelry.
- 5. To access certain attractions, it may be necessary to take a short walk or hike.
- 6. Tour members are encouraged to approach the unpredictable with optimism and bring positive energy, as this will ensure that we all enjoy the stunning scenery and create memorable moments together.

DAY 2

Game Drive in Greater Kruger National Park

- After breakfast, embark on a full-day game drive in an open safari vehicle.
- We will be accompanied by highly experienced field guide that will provide interesting information about the animals and their behavior.
- Stop at a designated picnic area for a leisurely lunch break.
- As the day progresses, animals tend to seek shelter from the heat, making it a bit more challenging to spot certain species. However, you may still come across predators, as well as rhinos, hippos, buffalo, and various bird species.
- After sunset, candle-lit barbecue buffet in the bush. An armed ranger provides protection from any carnivores that may wish to join the feast.
- A short night game drive after dinner to conclude the day.
