Come, join us, and embark on this fantastical journey to Switzerland!



Zurich airport - Lucerne - Iseltwald - Interlaken

- Upon arriving at Zurich Airport in the morning, private transfer to Lucerne, also known as the heart of Switzerland.
- Explore various medieval structures in Lucerne, including the iconic Chapel Bridge, Switzerland's oldest wooden bridge dating back to the 14th century, the Lion Monument, the Old Town, and other notable landmarks.
- After lunch, proceed to the charming town of Interlaken.
- Along the way, there will be a brief stop at Iseltwald, a popular filming location from "Crash Landing On You."

Interlaken - First Mountain Adventurous activities - Grindelwald

- After breakfast, we will visit the nearby village of Lauterbrunnen, home to the famous Staubbach Falls, where you can marvel at the waterfall cascading down.
- Following that, we'll head to the most beautiful town in Switzerland, Grindelwald. Nestled in a valley in the Bernese Oberland, north of the Alps, this village is surrounded by the stunning mountain trio of Eiger, Mönch, and Jungfrau. Despite its small size, Grindelwald has retained its rural charm.
- Take a cable car to First Mountain, the most beautiful and dreamlike mountain.
- The must-not-miss attractions include the First Cliff Walk, and various high-altitude activities such as First Glider, First Flyer, First Mountain Cart, etc. (Activities at your own expense).

Grindelwald Day Trip - Top of Europe

- We will reach the summit of Jungfrau, the "Top of Europe," via a combination of train and cable car. The Jungfrau holds the title of the highest railway station in Europe and offers breathtaking panoramic views.

Grindelwald - Montreux

- After breakfast, we will proceed to an idyllic town Montreux.
- It is located in the southwestern part of Switzerland, a picturesque town.
- After lunch, visit the medieval Chillon Castle on the shores of Lake Geneva, which appears to float on Lake Geneva when viewed from a distance.

Montreux - Zermatt

- After breakfast, we will head to one of the most beautiful towns in Switzerland, Zermatt. En route, you'll pass through beautiful farmlands, expansive mountain ranges, and deep valleys.
- Upon arrival, check-in at Zermatt town. After settling in, feel free to explore the town with its typical Alpine charm.
- The Matterhorn (4,478 meters), one of the most beautiful peaks in the Alps and a symbol of pride for Switzerland, is located near Zermatt.
- It is globally renowned for its distinctive pyramid shape, and the inspiration for the famous Toblerone chocolate also comes from the Matterhorn.

Zermatt Day Trip

- After breakfast, we will take the cogwheel train (Gornergrat Bahn) to Riffelberg. If the weather permits, you can walk to Lake Riffelsee, where you can admire the breathtaking reflection of the Matterhorn on the water's surface.
- Continue the journey by cogwheel train to the final station Gornergrat (3,135 meters). Here, you'll have a close-up view of the Matterhorn, the vast mountain ranges, and the spectacular Gornergrat Glacier.

Zermatt - Glacier Express - Andermatt - Zurich

- After breakfast, we will embark on the panoramic Glacier Express train from Zermatt to Andermatt, passing through the Alpine region and many picturesque lakes, enjoying the scenic views along the way. Later, we will take a private transport to Zurich.
- The old town area of Zurich is the most charming part of the city. Despite the age of the old buildings, strolling through the streets, you can feel the slow-paced medieval European atmosphere, making it a captivating experience.
- After checking in, we'll have free time to stroll around the old town of Zurich, and there will be ample time for shopping.



THINGS TO KNOW BEFORE COMING TO SWITZERLAND:

- Mid of Sep-Oct Temperature forecast: (Can change suddenly at any time)
 Lucerne: 16°C to 20°C°C
 - Grindelwald: 15 to 18°C
 - Zermatt: 10 to 15°C
 - Zurich: 15 to 20°C
 - Mountain area: 0 to 5°C
 - **The weather in Jungfrau and Zermatt can be quite cold**, so it's advisable to bring a thicker jacket or convenient-to-wear clothes."
- This is a mountain area, so the climate and weather here changes fast. If there is strong wind or snow, the entry of tourist spot will be closed for safety reason, so the itinerary may also need to be adjusted accordingly.
- The most beautiful scenery is always on the road, and some itineraries / scenic spots require a short walk to reach. Some small towns in Switzerland cannot be accessed by vehicles and can only rely on walking.
- We will change transportation modes, such as trains and cable cars, based on locations, providing group members with a more comprehensive Swiss experience.
- This is a private transport minibus tour, there is limited space for luggages. Therefore, it is recommended that the group members to bring a lighter luggage or a backpack. (Group members can bring: one medium luggage (26-28inch+), one hand carry + one small backpack). The luggage storage space requires everyone to cooperate.

DETAILS

- Departure: September Mid October (The date will be published on our FB and website)
- Group size: 12-14 members with 1 tour leader
- Private group: Contact us for arrangement and special discounts
- Tour fee: refer to the website

Remark:

- For solo travellers, we will do our best to find a roommate for you. Otherwise, a single-room supplement will apply.
- Once the group is formed, the tour leader will provide details regarding flight tickets. Participants are responsible for purchasing their own flight tickets and following up on the status of their tickets.
- Registration is confirmed upon receipt of the deposit payment. Limited spots are available on a first-come, first-served basis.

Term & Condition

- 1.A deposit is required for reservation. The full balance must be paid within the specified time frame, no later than 45 days before departure. Failure to comply may lead to reservation cancellation and deposit forfeiture.
- 2. Cancellation policy:
 - a. Cancellation of reservation must be made in writing to avoid any misunderstanding.
 - b. If no replacement is found, cancellation charges apply based on when we receive notice:
 - i.45 days or more before the date of departure Forfeiture of tour deposit
 - ii. 22 44 days before the date of departure 70% of tour fare non-refundable
 - iii. Within 21 days before the date of departure 100% of tour fare non-refundable
 - iv. No refund for fees already incurred and non-refundable from other relevant authorities, e.g., flight or train tickets
- 3. If there are any unforeseen circumstances or uncontrollable/force majeure (weather, tide, nature factor, traffic delays/cancellations, illness, pandemic, strikes, war or other causes), the company reserve the right to make changes to/cancel itinerary or postpone the tour at any time, no refunds are available.
- 4. Travel Document:
 - a. A tour member must have: An international passport or other recognized travel documents which should be valid for at least 6 months from the date of return to the country of origin; The necessary visa and vaccination and health certificates as required by the various authorities of the countries to be visited.
 - b. The company is not responsible for expenses, reimbursement, or tour price refund if a member is denied entry or deported due to improper documents or other reasons.
- 5. No refund or reduction will be made to any member in respect of airfare, accommodation, meals, sightseeing tours, transport or any other services which are included in the tour fare out not utilized by the tour member due to personal reasons.
- 6. The company reserves the right to cancel or withdraw any itinerary, or any reservation made for a client or decline to accept or retain any person from being a tour member if he is likely to endanger the health or safety, or impair the comfort or enjoyment of others on the tour.



1. Is the trip suitable for the elderly or children?

- Our trip suitable for all age groups. If you have conditions such as asthma, high blood pressure, heart disease, etc., it is advisable to consult a doctor's advice in advance.
- Going to areas with altitudes around 3000 meters may cause altitude sickness. For those with potential health risks, extra caution and medical guidance are particularly necessary.

2. Is the trip suitable for people with limited mobility?

• All our itineraries use comfortable travel buses, significantly reducing the amount of walking.

3. What season is the best for traveling to Switzerland?

- Switzerland is an attractive tourist destination throughout the year, with each season offering unique charm and activities. You can choose different seasons to visit Switzerland based on personal interests and travel plans.
- Spring/Summer/Autumn Outdoor activities are abundant (e.g., First Mountain Adventure & Paragliding).
- Winter Snowscapes & Hot Springs (recommend to join beginner ski).
- From mid-June to the end of August, when temperatures exceed 30 degrees Celsius, it is not advisable to visit.

4. What is the currency in Switzerland?

- Switzerland does not belong to the European Union. The currency used in Switzerland is the Swiss Franc (CHF), and the exchange rate is relatively favorable.
- Credit cards or debit cards are widely accepted in restaurants and shops. It is recommended that tour members use cards to avoid carrying too much cash, preventing unnecessary theft.

5. How is Swiss cuisine?

- Swiss cuisine reflects its diverse culture and geographical location, incorporating elements from Germany, France, Italy, etc.
- Notable dishes include cheese fondue, raclette, German sausages, etc.
- Dining expenses outside range from CHF30 and above per meal.
- Swiss supermarkets offer a variety of ready-to-eat foods for convenient and quick meals (e.g., sandwiches, salads, yogurt).
