### WHAT TO KNOW BEFORE COMING TO SIBERIA

- Lake Baikal experiences extremely cold temperatures during winter. Please be prepared for sub-zero temperatures. Bring appropriate winter clothing, including layered clothing, warm outerwear, hats, gloves, and sturdy boots.
  - In February, temperatures can range from -15°C to -20°C, but some days may be windy, leading to wind chill temperatures dropping to -20°C to -25°C, or even reaching -30°C at times.
- To visit certain attractions, you may need to take short walks in the extreme cold climate condition.
- Most of the tour's attractions are natural landscapes, and the itinerary may be subject to changes due to weather conditions and other factors, ensuring the best experience for our travelers.
- During the sightseeing tour at Olkhon Island, toilet facilities may be limited due to its remote and natural setting.
- Given the constrained capacity of the transportation, each group member is required to adhere to luggage restrictions, which include a medium suitcase (26inch), a hand luggage bag and a small daypack.
- Tour members are encouraged to approach unpredictable situations with a positive attitude and bring positive energy, ensuring that we all enjoy the breathtaking scenery and create unforgettable moments together.

- Suitable month: January, February & March
- Number of tour members in a group: Minimum 14 pax to form a group (20 pax maximum)
- Private Tour: Contact us for arrangement and special discounts
- Tour leader: Organizer will make arrangements and adjustments according to the schedule of all tour leaders under Bucket List Ticked and the entry and exit policies of various countries

4b). The company is not responsible for expenses, reimbursement, or tour price refund if a member is denied entry or deported due to improper documents or other reasons.



#### Is it currently unsafe to travel to Russia?

Russia is an expansive nation, and Irkutsk (Lake Baikal) is situated thousands of kilometers distant from Moscow and the Russia-Ukraine border. In general the attitude of Russian people didn't change towards foreigners. They are still very interested in where you are from, why you visit their country and what places you want to see.

#### Is a Visa required for traveling to Russia?

A visa is generally necessary for the entry of most foreign citizens into Russia. Notably, the **eVisa application** has been reintroduced, as of August 2023. For more info, check out https://evisa.kdmid.ru/.

#### What is the weather like around Lake Baikal during winter?

The winter climate around Lake Baikal is extremely cold, characterized by temperatures frequently plummeting significantly below freezing. It's quite typical for the temperatures to plummet to around -25°C or even lower during this season. This cold weather is attributed to the region's geographical location and its large surface area, which contribute to the intensity of the winter chill.

#### What health precautions should I take?

Dress in layers to prevent frostbite and hypothermia. Stay hydrated and eat warm meals to maintain energy levels.

#### What is the currency used? How much cash do I need to prepare?

The currency is Ruble. It's essential to be aware that foreign bank or credit cards is now not usable, necessitating the need to carry US dollar (2009 onwards) to convert into Rubles.

#### What kind of clothing should I pack for a winter visit to Lake Baikal?

Pack warm clothing including insulated jackets, thermal layers, gloves, hats, scarves, waterproof pants, warm socks, and sturdy boots. Layering is key for staying comfortable in the extreme cold.

#### What's the significance of Lake Baikal in winter photography?

Lake Baikal's frozen landscapes, unique ice formations, and the contrast of frozen lake against snow-covered surroundings make it a captivating subject for winter photography.

#### Can I walk on the frozen Lake Baikal during winter?

Yes, during the colder months, the surface of Lake Baikal freezes over and becomes a vast expanse of ice. However, it's crucial to ensure that the ice is thick enough and safe for walking. Local guides or authorities can provide information on safe ice conditions.

#### Is infrastructure consistent across the Irkutsk region?

Major cities have good infrastructure, but remote areas such as in Olkhon island might lack amenities. Harsh weather conditions can result in power outages and restricted access to hot water services.


