INTRODUCTION

Norway is undoubtedly one of the world's most beautiful countries, known for its stunning fjords, the spectacular Northern Lights, and several fantastically modern, yet somehow charming cities.

The name of the country was originally the "Road to the North". Legend tells that the ancient Nordic people traveled between Scandinavia and there was a "North Road" along the northern coast of the island, hence the name.

Norway is located in the western part of Scandinavia in Northern Europe. Its north extends to the northernmost point of Europe whereas the south faces Denmark across the sea. Norway has many coastal islands, reaching 150,000 and it is one of the countries with the most mountains in Europe. Fjords, mountains, and glaciers account for about 75% of the country's land area.

THINGS TO KNOW BEFORE GOING TO NORWAY:

1. Norway's weather is unpredictable. We may have to meet road closure when the weather is bad, and face unexpected situations at any time, and then change our itinerary / accommodation. (⚠️ Tour members have to bear for any additional expenses or economic losses that may be incurred in the event of road closure due to bad weather).
2. Some attractions require a short walk to reach.
3. Tour members have no underlying diseases (asthma, heart disease) and have enough equipment to withstand the cold temperature.
4. The aurora will be tracked throughout the journey, but the aurora is a peculiar natural phenomenon that requires luck and positive mindset, and can only be seen when the weather is clear. If necessary, we may drive out to see it more closely.
5. This tour is a self-drive tour (leader = photographer = driver, tour member doesn't need to drive). Accommodation will be changed everyday, so that group members can have a better experience of staying in Norway.
6. The car compartment space is limited as this is a self-drive tour. Hence there are restrictions on the luggage size.

- Tour leader: Organizer will make arrangements and adjustments according to the schedule of all tour leaders under Bucket List Ticked and the entry and exit policies of various countries

Remark:

- Tour leader will inform tour members the details of flight, tour members will need to buy their own air tickets, as well as follow up the status of the ticket.
- Deposit is needed for seat reservation. First-come, first-available.

Term & Condition

1. A deposit is required for reservation. The full balance must be paid within the specified time frame, no later than 45 days before departure. Failure to comply may lead to reservation cancellation and deposit forfeiture.
2. Cancellation policy:
 - a. Cancellation of reservation must be made in writing to avoid any misunderstanding.
 - b. If no replacement is found, cancellation charges apply based on when we receive notice:
 - i. 45 days or more before the date of departure - Forfeiture of tour deposit
 - ii. 22 - 44 days before the date of departure - 70% of tour fare non-refundable
 - iii. Within 21 days before the date of departure - 100% of tour fare non-refundable
 - iv. No refund for fees already incurred and non-refundable from other relevant authorities, e.g., flight or train tickets
3. If there are any unforeseen circumstances or uncontrollable/force majeure (weather, tide, nature factor, traffic delays/cancellations, illness, pandemic, strikes, war or other causes), the company reserve the right to make changes to/cancel itinerary or postpone the tour at any time, no refunds are available.
4. Travel Document:
 - a. A tour member must have: An international passport or other recognized travel documents which should be valid for at least 6 months from the date of return to the country of origin; The necessary visa and vaccination and health certificates as required by the various authorities of the countries to be visited.
 - b. The company is not responsible for expenses, reimbursement, or tour price refund if a member is denied entry or deported due to improper documents or other reasons.
5. No refund or reduction will be made to any member in respect of airfare, accommodation, meals, sightseeing tours, transport or any other services which are included in the tour fare out not utilized by the tour member due to personal reasons.
6. The company reserves the right to cancel or withdraw any itinerary, or any reservation made for a client or decline to accept or retain any person from being a tour member if he is likely to endanger the health or safety, or impair the comfort or enjoyment of others on the tour.
7. All members are advised to purchase travel insurance for added protection against various unforeseen events.
