INTRODUCTION

THINGS TO KNOW BEFORE COMING TO EGYPT & JORDAN:

- 1. During winter period, Egypt and Jordan have a pleasant climate, cool and comfortable weather to travel. However, the tour mostly are in the desert area, strongly advice group members must take dust-proof measures due to the sands and dust. Desert climate can be unpredictable, sunny, cloudy or rainy. Itinerary may change with unexpected situations occur. Warmth-wear is recommended at night as temperature may drop to 10 degrees with cold and windy.
 - a. Dead sea region: 14°C/23°C
 - b.Petra: 7°C/20°C
 - c. Wadi Rum: 4°C/15°C
 - d.Cairo: 10°C/24°C
 - e. Sahara Desert Bahariya oasis: 4°C/21°C
 - f.Luxor: 7°C/24°C
 - g.Hurghada: 12°C/24°C
- 2. The safety issues of Egypt and Jordan is not too dangerous, however it is recommended that the group members take good care of the valuables and do not take it lightly. In addition, Jordan's currency is one of the highest in the world. The expenses can be high, group members to check with the price before spending.
- 3. Some itineraries/attractions require a short distance of walk, not suitable for one with limited mobility.
- 4. Group members require to have a strong physical fitness, no underlying diseases (asthma, high blood pressure, heart disease) and adequate equipment to withstand temperature changes.

1	 After breakfast, we will visit Petra again. Today we will spend a whole day exploring the ancient city of Petra. Ancient Petra was known as the trading center of the Middle East, an important crossroads between Egypt, Syria, and even Greece and Rome. In the beginning of the 2nd century AD, Petra became a client state of the Roman Empire, the architectural remains from Roman period. The city is full of carved buildings, this forms a unique "stone city" (Petra means "stone" in ancient Greek). As the rocks are mostly in maroon, especially charming under the reflection of the sunrise and sunset, Petra also has the reputation of "rose city". In 1812, John Becktint, a British-Swiss man, uncovered the mystery of the "Stone City". The main attractions to visit in Petra include The Siq, Khazaneh temple, The Theater, etc. Go to Amman in the evening. Check in Amman hotel. 	Overnight in Amman hotel Breakfast and dinner provided


