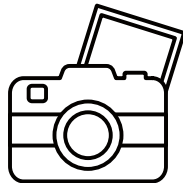

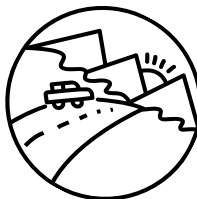


01 PHOTO MEMORIES BY TOUR LEADER

The journey will primarily utilize a large 16-passenger SUV, offering spacious seating.

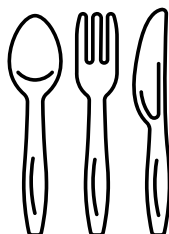
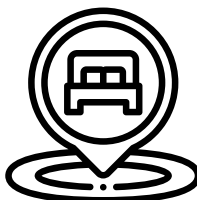


03 AURORA WATCHING

Accommodation will be changed almost everyday, so tour members can have a more complete Lapland stay experience.

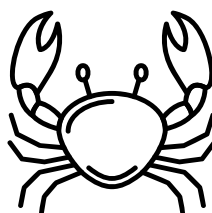


05 FLEXIBLE DINING

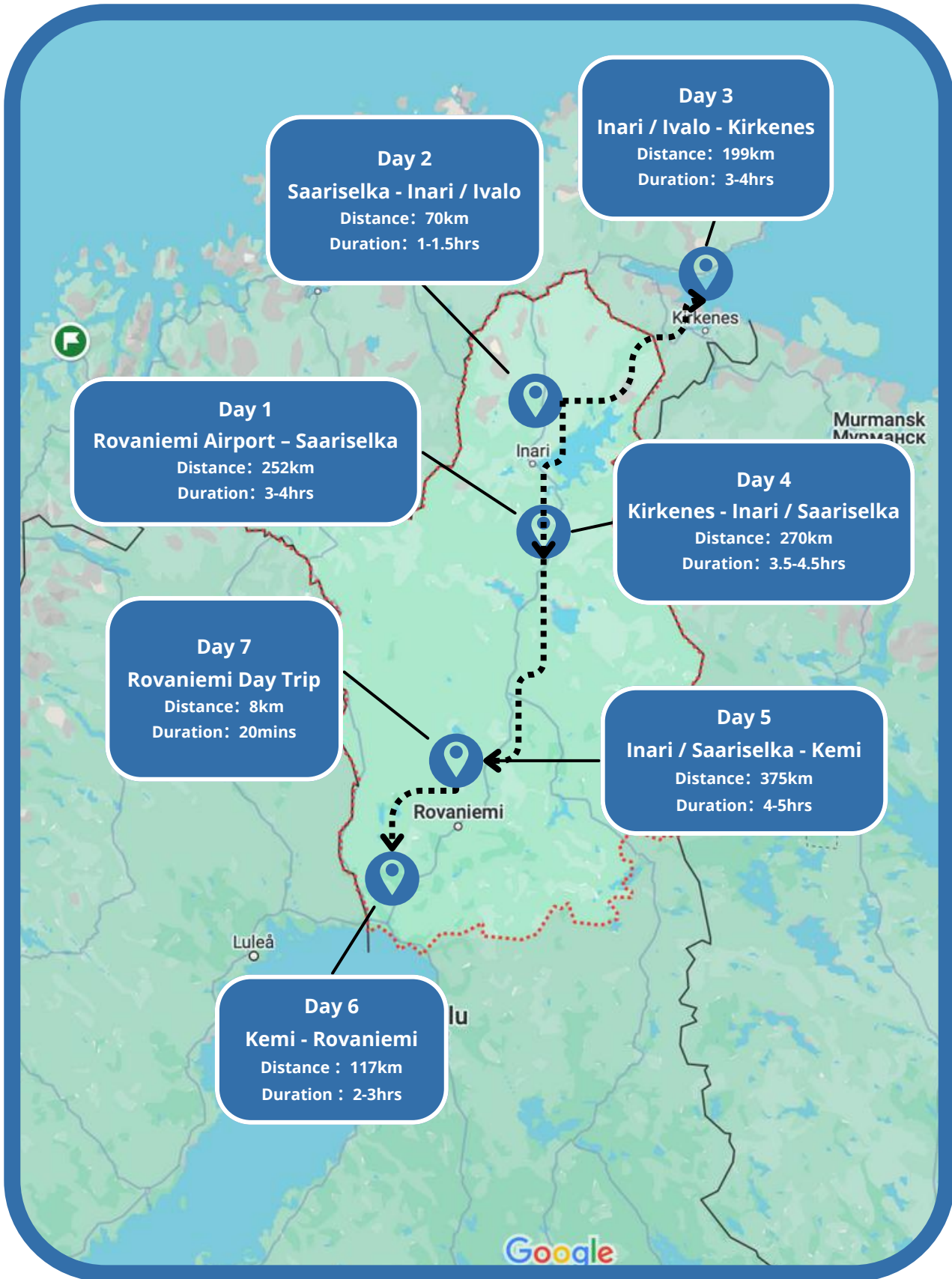

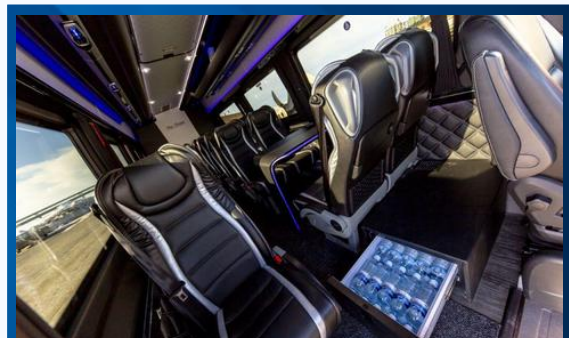

WHAT TO KNOW BEFORE COMING TO LAPPLAND

Local temperatures in Nov, Dec and Jan (only for reference)

Inari

-15°C/-5°C

Kemi

-12°C/-1°C

Kirkenes

-11°C/-2°C

Rovaniemi

-10°C/0°C

Saariselka

-14°C/-3°C

- Lapland's weather can be unpredictable, with strong winds, hail and snowstorms, and even road closures in severe cases. At any time, you will have to face the occurrence of unexpected situations, and then change the itinerary/accommodation.
- Some itineraries/attractions require a short walk to reach them.
- Group members need to have strong physical fitness, no underlying diseases (asthma, high blood pressure, heart disease) and adequate equipment to withstand the cold winter temperatures.
- **Winter in Lapland has short daylight and long stretch of nights, daylight last about 4-5 hours (sunrise 10.30am, sunset 3pm).**
- The aurora will be tracked throughout the journey, but the aurora is a very strange natural phenomenon that requires luck and a positive attitude, and can only be seen when the weather is clear. If necessary, we may drive out to a closer place for viewing.

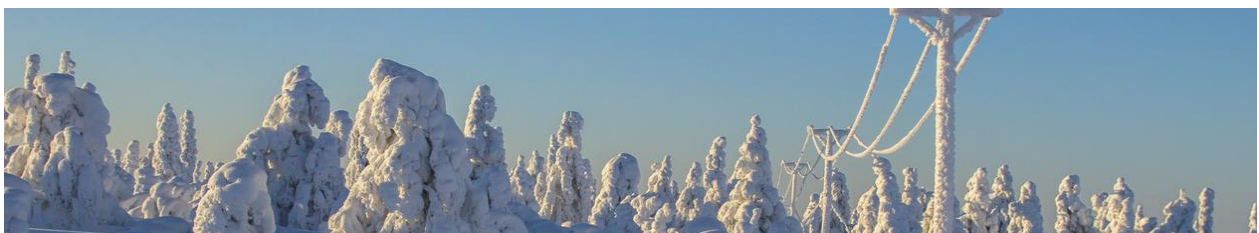
Remark:

- Tour leader will inform tour members the details of flight, tour members will need to buy their own air tickets, as well as follow up the status of the ticket.
- Deposit is needed for seat reservation. First-come, first-available.

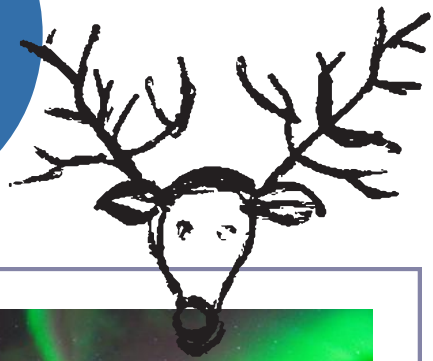
Term & Condition

1. A deposit is required for reservation. The full balance must be paid within the specified time frame, no later than 45 days before departure. Failure to comply may lead to reservation cancellation and deposit forfeiture.
2. Cancellation policy:
 - a. Cancellation of reservation must be made in writing to avoid any misunderstanding.
 - b. If no replacement is found, cancellation charges apply based on when we receive notice:
 - i. 45 days or more before the date of departure - Forfeiture of tour deposit
 - ii. 22 - 44 days before the date of departure - 70% of tour fare non-refundable
 - iii. Within 21 days before the date of departure - 100% of tour fare non-refundable
 - iv. No refund for fees already incurred and non-refundable from other relevant authorities, e.g., flight or train tickets
3. If there are any unforeseen circumstances or uncontrollable/force majeure (weather, tide, nature factor, traffic delays/cancellations, illness, pandemic, strikes, war or other causes), the company reserve the right to make changes to/cancel itinerary or postpone the tour at any time, no refunds are available.
4. Travel Document:
 - a. A tour member must have: An international passport or other recognized travel documents which should be valid for at least 6 months from the date of return to the country of origin; The necessary visa and vaccination and health certificates as required by the various authorities of the countries to be visited.
 - b. The company is not responsible for expenses, reimbursement, or tour price refund if a member is denied entry or deported due to improper documents or other reasons.
5. No refund or reduction will be made to any member in respect of airfare, accommodation, meals, sightseeing tours, transport or any other services which are included in the tour fare out not utilized by the tour member due to personal reasons.
6. The company reserves the right to cancel or withdraw any itinerary, or any reservation made for a client or decline to accept or retain any person from being a tour member if he is likely to endanger the health or safety, or impair the comfort or enjoyment of others on the tour.

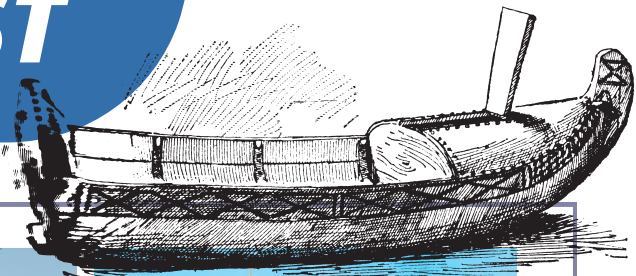

FAQ

1. Where is Lapland?

Lapland is not actually a country in itself, but is in fact made up of regions in Northern Finland, Sweden and Norway. Lapland is traditionally the home of nomadic reindeer herders and of course Lapland's most famous resident... Santa Claus!

2. When is the best season to visit Lapland?

Lapland is suitable for visiting in all seasons. However, winter offers fantastic outdoor activities such as husky sledding, reindeer sleigh rides, icebreaking cruises, snowmobiling, and more.

3. What is the weather like in Lapland?

Lapland only has an average of 5 hours of daylight a day known as "grey light" - this is generally between 10am and 3pm - The rest of the time is like night time.

4. How cold will it be in Lapland?

Lapland is situated above the Arctic Circle, where temperatures frequently drop well below freezing. During the peak tourism season from December to February, the average temperature in Lapland ranges from -20°C to 3°C, depending on the location, and it can feel even colder due to wind chill. Please make sure to bring appropriate clothing, such as hats, gloves, scarves, warm layers, and thermal wear.

5. Is kid / elderly suitable to go to Lapland?

Young children are particularly vulnerable to the cold weather conditions; therefore we do not recommend for children under 3 years of age. For the elderly considering a trip to Lapland, health considerations are important, with attention to mobility, cold tolerance, and comfort (consult doctor before signing up for the trip).

6. Can you see the Northern Lights in Lapland?

Unique to the Arctic Circle, during your Lapland holiday you may be lucky enough to see the spectacle that is the Northern Lights (Aurora Borealis).

7. What is the currency of Lapland?

The currency of Lapland is the euro (EUR). However, it is advisable to use a credit card or debit card, as they are widely accepted everywhere in Lapland.

8. How is the food in Lapland?

The food in Lapland primarily consists of wild game meat, wild berries, and local specialties. Reindeer meat is one of the common ingredients, offering a rich variety of unique flavors.

9. The cost of dining out in Lapland is approximately how much?

A meal in Lapland typically costs around EUR 30 or more.
